

## **Foster Contract**

The foster parent is responsible for feeding, cleaning, and caring for their foster animal. They must provide food and water for all animals, litter for cats, and walks for dogs. Kittens under six months require wet food. Some kittens may require kitten replacement milk (KMR). Please be aware of these expenses.

All foster cats must be kept indoors unless in a carrier during transport. Dogs must be kept indoors unless on a leash and with foster parent.

All vet visits must be cleared by Lucky You! administration prior to the visit. If a foster parent chooses to go to the emergency veterinarian without consent or an unapproved appointment, the expense falls upon the foster parent.

Expenses for Spay/neuter surgery, vaccinations, microchipping, and combo tests will be paid for by Lucky You! Animal Rescue. Humane euthanasia, vet visits, and clinic care will be reimbursed only if pre-approved.

Foster parents must weigh kittens and puppies frequently, preferably daily. Any kitten or puppy weight loss should be promptly reported to administration so action can be taken. Digital food scales will be provided if needed.

Foster parents may be required to administer medications, treatments, bathing solutions, etc. as deemed necessary to foster animals in their care.

Foster parents are encouraged to attend events at which Lucky You is represented, with their healthy fosters.

Lucky You administrators may also request fosters be made available to attend any events that you may not be able to attend. Fosters will be asked to aide administrators with pick up and drop off, flexibility and appropriate transport necessities for their animals.

Foster parents are encouraged to take pictures (and videos) and write biographies for their animals. Please share these with administration and they will be added to the website and/or Facebook page.

A foster parent can apply to adopt his/her own foster animal and has first adoption rights to that foster. The adoption fee will still apply.

Healthy cats and kittens over 2 pounds will be spayed/neutered and made available for adoption within one week of surgery. Foster parents should be prepared for this. It is critical they are available for adoption when they are still young, small, and highly adoptable.

Foster parents may arrange meets with potential adopters in their homes or approved store locations. We advise that foster parents do not meet strangers alone or allow them into their home. Lucky You! administration can be available to assist. All final adoptions must be approved by administration.

Lucky You! can revoke fostering privileges at any time and for any reason.

Upon receiving my new foster animal(s), I agree to hold harmless Lucky You! Animal Rescue, forever, from liability for any damages or injury to persons or property, which may be caused by said animal(s).

I have read all of the above statements and understand their meanings entirely. I agree to all of the above, and know that my failure to follow or comply with any of this can result in immediate termination as a foster parent, and removal of foster animals from my home.
